The sculpture is a representation of the deity's face, known as the 'Mukha' or 'Mukha Prasad'. It is made of wood and is highly decorated with gold and green. The crown is a 'Makuta' or 'Makuta Prasad', which is a traditional headgear of the deity. The face is painted with a reddish-pink color, and the eyes are large and expressive. The mustache and teeth are also painted in detail. The sculpture is a significant part of the Tirumala temple's heritage and is displayed in the Tirumala Museum.
