

## Silpakorn University



### *History of the university*

In 1939, the Praneet Silpakorn school was founded on the grounds of Thapra Palace by Mom Luang Pin Malagula. Four years later, during World War II, it became Thailand's third government university. It was founded by Italian-born art professor Corrado Ferrocini, his Thai name is Silpa Bhirasri. It is leading Thai university in the fine arts and Archaeology, In 1968 the Royal Thai Education Ministry granted permission for Silpakorn University to include additional majors, which led to the establishment of Sanam Chan campus in Nakhon Pathom, west of Bangkok.

At the present time, the university has several campuses

1. Thapra Palace, Bangkok
2. Sanam Chan Palace, Nakhon Pathom
3. Phetchaburi
